

PROJECT: CHASTAIN PARK PATH

DESCRIPTION

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The PATH Foundation selected GDP to construct 3,000 linear feet of 10' wide concrete walking trails along the northwest section of Chastain Park in Atlanta. The urban trailway included granite and formed concrete curbing, striping, and extensive landscaping alongside it. Additional scopes involved resurfacing and striping an adjacent 250 space parking lot, installing a concrete paver driveway, and creating a grasspave drive for fire access and increased stormwater percolation on the site. GDP also built a new ADA compliant entrance into the park amphitheater and reconfigured a road intersection leading into the park.
