DESCRIPTION

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Consolidated Macon-Bibb County in partnership with GDOT and New Town Macon selected Georgia Development Partners to build a trail system and park on the former Amerson Water Works. This project provided the citizens of Bibb County passive recreational activities through the 200 acres of forests, meadows and wetlands along the scenic Ocmulgee River. GDP constructed over five miles of new concrete multi-use trails, two boat ramps, overlooks, and pavilions. Several portions of work required working in the Ocmulgee River and other environmentally sensitive areas. This was the second project and a critical linkage in the Ocmulgee Heritage Trail Master Plan Georgia Development Partners has completed for Macon-Bibb and New Town Macon.
