

PROJECT: GLENLAKE PARK AND BATHHOUSE

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In November of 2008, The City of Decatur chose Georgia Development Partners to construct the Glenlake Park and Bathhouse. This two phased project updated an aging pool facility as well as rejuvenated elements of a regional park. GDP demolished and removed the outdated bathhouse and surrounding decking, constructed a new 2,800 square foot bathhouse that included restrooms, showers, common area and office space. GDP reconfigured the design of the pool itself and installed new decking. In addition, age specific play areas were added, along with structural masonry walls, decorative shade sails and structures, architectural fencing, lighting, and other hardscape features.
