

PROJECT: NOONDAY KENNESAW MOUNTAIN NATIONAL BATTLEFIELD

SITE PLAN



DESCRIPTION

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Cobb County in conjunction with the United States Department of the Interior awarded GDP the task of expanding public access within the historically sensitive and significant Kennesaw Mountain National Battlefield. GDP expanded a multi-purpose concrete path 3,500 linear feet, installed over 1,500 linear feet of split rail fencing, and added a new 287 space parking lot that included an extensive subterranean stormwater retention system. A solar powered security gate was also constructed to close the lot off to the public access after hours. GDP had to work closely with the Park Service in following strict protocol and giving special attention while disturbing areas of historic significance.
